Introduction

This proposal outlines the plan to procure 10,000 MT of fly ash-for next four months. Considering the critical role fly ash plays in our operations and the reliability of our current vendor, we aim to ensure a seamless procurement process while maintaining cost-effectiveness. The maximum acceptable price for this procurement shall be Nu. 1,700 per MT.

Objective

The objective of this procurement is to acquire high-quality fly ash at competitive rates to meet our production requirements. By using a limited inquiry process, we intend to leverage the existing vendor relationship to secure the best possible terms.

Price Table

Bidders are required to quote the quantity of fly ash they can supply at each price point listed below. The prices start at Nu. 1,700 per MT and decrement by Nu. 10 until reaching Nu. 1,600 per MT. The quantities must be filled in the table provided below:

Instructions to Bidders

1. Submission Requirements:

- o Bidders must fill in the table with the quantity of fly ash they can supply at each respective price point.
- o The completed table should be submitted as part of the bid documentation.
- o The bidders should quote in a password protected form and send it to procurement, <u>procurement@dccl.bt</u>
- The passwords will be asked only during the time of opening. Please do not share the passwords while submitting.

2. Pricing:

- o The maximum price for this procurement is set at Nu. 1,700 per MT.
- o Bidders are encouraged to quote the most competitive prices at which they can supply the required quantity.



3. Quantity Allocation:

- o Bidders must specify the quantity they can supply at each price point. This will help in understanding the price-quantity relationship and aid in decision-making.
- The total quantity across all price points should cumulatively meet or exceed 15,000 MT.

4. Evaluation Criteria:

- o Bids will be evaluated based on the total cost and the ability to meet the required quantity.
- o Preference will be given to the lowest prices that cumulatively fulfil the total requirement of 10,000 MT.

5. Deadline:

- o All bids must be submitted by 30th June 2025.
- o Late submissions will not be considered.
- o The bids will be opened on 1st July 2025

- All communications should be in writing and submitted before the deadline.

7. Contract Terms:

- o The selected bidder(s) will be required to sign a contract detailing the supply terms, including delivery schedules and payment terms.
